DIRECTIONS:

From Route 22

...to Asa Packer Campus

Take Route 22 to main Bethlehem exit (Route 378). Route 378 heads only south; continue for 3.6 miles and when you cross the bridge over the Lehigh River, be careful to stay in the left lane. At the far end of the bridge, turn left at the traffic light onto Third Street. Continue one block to traffic light at Brodhead Ave. and turn right. Continue on Brodhead for two blocks and turn left onto Packer Ave. Continue straight until Taylor St. Turn right onto Taylor St. and travel one and on-half blocks to Taylor Gymnasium or Grace Hall (both building are on the left).

...to Murray H. Goodman Campus

Take Rt. 22 to the main Bethlehem exit (Route 378). Route 378 (Wyandotte St.) heads only south; continue for 3.6 miles and when you cross the bridge over the Lehigh River, be careful to stay in the right lane. Continue south on 378 traveling in the left hand lane up Wyandotte St. hill over the top of the mountain. At the top of the mountain there is a light and a gasoline station on your left. Proceed to the next light, approximately a ¼ mile, and make a left hand turn onto Seidersville Road. Continue down the hill until the road forks; bear right. Follow to traffic light, approximately 1.5 miles, and turn onto Mountain Drive South. Continue for ½ mile and the Goodman Campus is on the right.

From Route 378 off Route 309 (Northeast Extension of PA Turnpike---Exit 32)

...to Asa Packer Campus

After taking exit 32 of the Northeast Extension of the PA Turnpike, turn left on Route 663 and travel to Route 309 in Quakertown. Travel north on 309 to Center Valley; turn right onto Route 378 North (to Bethlehem). Travel approximately five miles to the top of the mountain, and continue halfway down the far side. At the second flashing yellow light, make a right onto Summit Street. Follow Summit Street to the end and turn left onto Brodhead Ave. Travel two blocks and turn right onto Packer Ave. Follow Packer Ave. to Taylor St. and turn right onto Taylor to either Taylor Gymnasium or Grace Hall.

...to Murray H. Goodman Campus

After taking exit 32 of the Northeast Extension of the PA Turnpike, turn left on Route 663 and travel to Route 309 in Quakertown. Travel north on 309 to Center Valley; turn right onto Route 378 North (to Bethlehem) and travel app. 2.2 miles to the second light and Saucon Valley Road. Turn right onto Saucon Valley Road and follow to the end, 1.5 miles. Turn left onto Bingen Road and travel approximately one mile (look for blue sign that reads "Goodman Campus"). At the traffic light go straight onto Mountain Drive South for ½ mile and Goodman Campus is on the right.

From Interstate 78 (Exit #67 Hellerton/Bethlehem)

...to Asa Packer Campus

Westbound...Motorists coming from I-78 westbound should use the Hellertown Exit #67 (formerly #21). At the red light, continue straight and follow the signs for Lehigh University. At the second stop sign make a right onto Mountain Drive South. Follow Mountain Drive to the top of South Mountain, at the fork at the top of the mountain, bear left. At the following fork in the road bear right to the stop sign. Take the second left through the stone gates onto Lower Sayre Park Road. Follow Lower Sayre Park Road down the mountain. Bear right at the next fork in the road onto Sayre Drive. Turn left at the stop sign facing Taylor College (a green building). About 50 feet ahead is the next stop sign. Turn right onto University Drive. At the stop sign, turn left.

After making the left Grace Hall will be the 2^{nd} building on your right, and Taylor Gym will be the 4^{th} building on the right.

Eastbound...Motorists coming from I-78 eastbound should use the Hellertown Exit #67 (formerly #21). At the red light make a right, and at the second red light make a left and continue straight following the signs for Lehigh University. At the second stop sign make a right onto Mountain Drive South. Follow Mountain Drive to the top of South Mountain, at the fork at the top of the mountain, bear left. At the following fork in the road bear right to the stop sign. Take the second left through the stone gates onto Lower Sayre Park Road. Follow Lower Sayre Park Road down the mountain. Bear right at the next fork in the road onto Sayre Drive. Turn left at the stop sign facing Taylor College (a green building). About 50 feet ahead is the next stop sign. Turn right onto University Drive. At the stop sign, turn left. After making the left Grace Hall will be the 2nd building on your right, and Taylor Gym will be the 4th building on the right.

...to Murray H. Goodman Campus

Westbound...Motorists coming from I-78 westbound should use the Hellertown Exit #67 (formerly #21). At the red light, continue straight and follow the signs for Lehigh University. At the second stop sign make a left onto Mountain Drive South. Make the first left hand turn on Goodman Drive.

Eastbound...Motorists coming from I-78 eastbound should use the Hellertown Exit #67 (formerly #21). At the red light make a right, and at the second red light make a left and continue straight following the signs for Lehigh University. . At the second stop sign make a left onto Mountain Drive South. Make the first left hand turn on Goodman Drive.

TAILGATES:

Please inform parent and alumni groups of our tailgate policy for pre and/or post game gatherings:

All groups must be registered at least 24 hours before the event by calling our Athletic Facilities Office (610) 758-3395. The groups will be given a location in a <u>designated parking area to</u>

tailgate for not more than 1 ½ hours following the end of the competition. In the event of inclement weather, there will be no indoor tailgating facilities available.

Alcoholic beverages and the use of tobacco are not permitted at any competition site due to Lehigh University, Patriot League and NCAA policy (only permitted in designated parking areas).

SPORTSMANSHIP:

Patriot League and Lehigh University policy states:

"We ask that you join us, coaches, players, and officials in practicing good sportsmanship in supporting your teams and in your conduct toward players, coaches, officials and other spectators. Unruly and disrespectful behavior will not be condoned. [Please note that the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and the use of tobacco also are prohibited. Spectators are not allowed on the playing field at any time.]"
