

Information for Lehigh Home Game Event Management for Men's & Women's Cross Country

SITE: Lehigh University Cross Country Course – Murray H. Goodman Campus (#15 on map). **Pets, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, and coolers are not permitted on the course.**

PARKING: *Team vehicle parking* will be available in the Stabler Arena parking lots (letter B on map). *Spectator parking* is available in the Stabler Arena parking lots (letter B on map). Handicap parking will be permitted at Goodman Stadium (#1 on map). No Parking is permitted on College Drive (formerly Seidersville Rd.). All parking is subject to change as directed by event staff.

LOCKER FACILITIES : Located in Goodman Stadium House (#13 on map). The facility will be open 1½ hours before game time. A locker room attendant will direct your team to the appropriate rooms. Due to minimal locker room space, a locker room will be designated for all visiting women's athletes, and a second locker room designated for all visiting men's athletes. No locks or towels will be provided. Please have your team shower and change directly following the end of the competition. The locker facilities will be available for one hour after an event. Locker rooms are available for team members and official travel party ONLY.

ATHLETIC TRAINING: Sports Medicine Facilities – The host institution's athletic training room in Goodman Stadium will be available to the visiting athletic trainer(s). Any special needs, taping, treatment, or requests must be communicated to the host institution at least 48 hours prior to the contest (Sports Medicine Office: 610-758-4311). A prescription from a doctor or certified athletic trainer is required unless accompanied by a certified athletic trainer. No modalities may be administered by a non-certified student athletic trainer. Ice and water will be available at the site.

PRE-GAME WARM-UPS: The course will be available one hour before start time.

TAILGATES: The Lehigh University tailgate policy for pre and /or post game gatherings:

1. All groups must **be registered at least 24 hours before the event** by calling our Athletic Facilities Office: 610-758-3395. The groups will be given a location in a designated parking area to tailgate for not more than 1½ hours following the end of the competition. **As is true with all tailgating at Lehigh (including football), there will be no indoor tailgating facilities available.**
2. Please encourage your team to shower and use the locker facilities immediately following their competition. The locker facilities will be available for one hour after an event.
3. Alcoholic beverages and tobacco are not permitted at any competition site due to Lehigh University, Patriot League, and NCAA policy (only permitted in designated parking area).

SPORTSMANSHIP: Patriot League and Lehigh University policy states:

“Lehigh University and the Patriot League promote good sporting behavior by student-athletes, coaches, and spectators. We encourage everyone to actively support all participants of today's game and ask that you express your enthusiasm in a respectful and sporting-like manner. Please note that the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages (and use of tobacco) also are prohibited. Spectators are not allowed on the playing field at any time.” Thank you. **Our events management staff has the responsibility to enforce this policy and may choose to eject fans that do not comply.**
